Makino Milling Machine Co., Ltd. jointly received a special award of '23rd Logistics Environment Award' sponsored by Japan Association for Logistics and Transport with ISUZU LOGISTICS Co., Ltd. and THE SUMITOMO WAREHOUSE Co., Ltd.

'Logistics Environment Award' was established in June 2000 by Japan Association for Logistics and Transport aimed to promote environmental conservation and raise environmental awareness in the logistics sector, and to recognize organizations, companies, or individuals who have contributed to the sound development of logistics. This time, the company was recognized for its efforts to reduce CO2 emissions through round-use of the Container.


Specific Initiatives

Conventionally, after imported and unloaded at the Port of Yokohama, the containers were transported to our factory in Fujiyoshida City, Yamanashi Prefecture, and then empty containers returned to the Port of Yokohama.

In the new method, the empty containers are transferred to Isuzu Logistics based in Fujisawa City, Kanagawa Prefecture, and after the export cargo is packed, the container is delivered to the yard at the Port of Yokohama. In this way, the round-use system was established so that a single vehicle can complete the entire process on the same day.

Effect

We initiated in October 2020 until now round-used about 160 Nos of 40-foot containers, reducing the total transportation distance by more than 10,000 km and CO2 emissions by about 10 tons (about 0.06 tons-CO2 per trip).



We will continue to engage in environmental friendly activities in all of our future manufacturing processes.
